# Organization's structure

# Our policies

We are committed to ensure that modern slavery and human trafficking is not taking place in our business. Anti-slavery policy reflects our commitment to work ethically and in a transparent manner to exclude risks of modern slavery. This policy is adherent with internal policies and instructions regulating business processes in our group.

#### Risk assessment

As our sub-contractors, suppliers and other service providers are based throughout the world, before their engagement we perform due-diligence process to check the compliance with our standards and internal policies.

### Steps to assess and manage risks

To ensure that our business and business activities of our suppliers and sub-contractors comply with quality standards defined, our group intend to take following steps to combat slavery and human trafficking:

- To assess internal and external risks of slavery and human trafficking in own operations;
- To assess risks with existing and new sub-contractors, suppliers and other services providers and ascertain that
  modern slavery and human trafficking are not taking place. Where suppliers or sub-contractors have not
  published an Anti-Slavery Statement, they are required to confirm that they have in place such ethical
  employment practices;
- If the risk of slavery or human trafficking would be identified in our own business or business of our partners, appropriate steps shall be undertaken to comply with all relevant laws and regulations;
- Employees are instructed to report any concerns or doubts of slavery and human trafficking inside and outside UPB.
